

April 2017 Result: Contact Energy Leads April's Gain

Australian CleanTech Index rose 0.5% in April underperforming the ASX200.

The Australian CleanTech Index rose from 56.61 to 56.90 over the month of April recording a **0.5% gain**. This compared to the ASX200 gain of 1.0% and the ASX Small Ordinaries Index loss of 0.3%. The **Australian CleanTech 20** rose by 0.6% for the month.

However, the CleanTech Index continues to outperform the wider market over the last 12 and 36 months. **The 3 year performance still leads the ASX200 by over 40%.**

The best performing sub-index for the month was the Australian Renewable Energy Index with a 1.5% gain, led by Contact Energy. The worst performing sub-index was the Australian Efficiency & Storage Index that recorded a 1.5% loss for the month led by a 9% loss from Galaxy Resources.

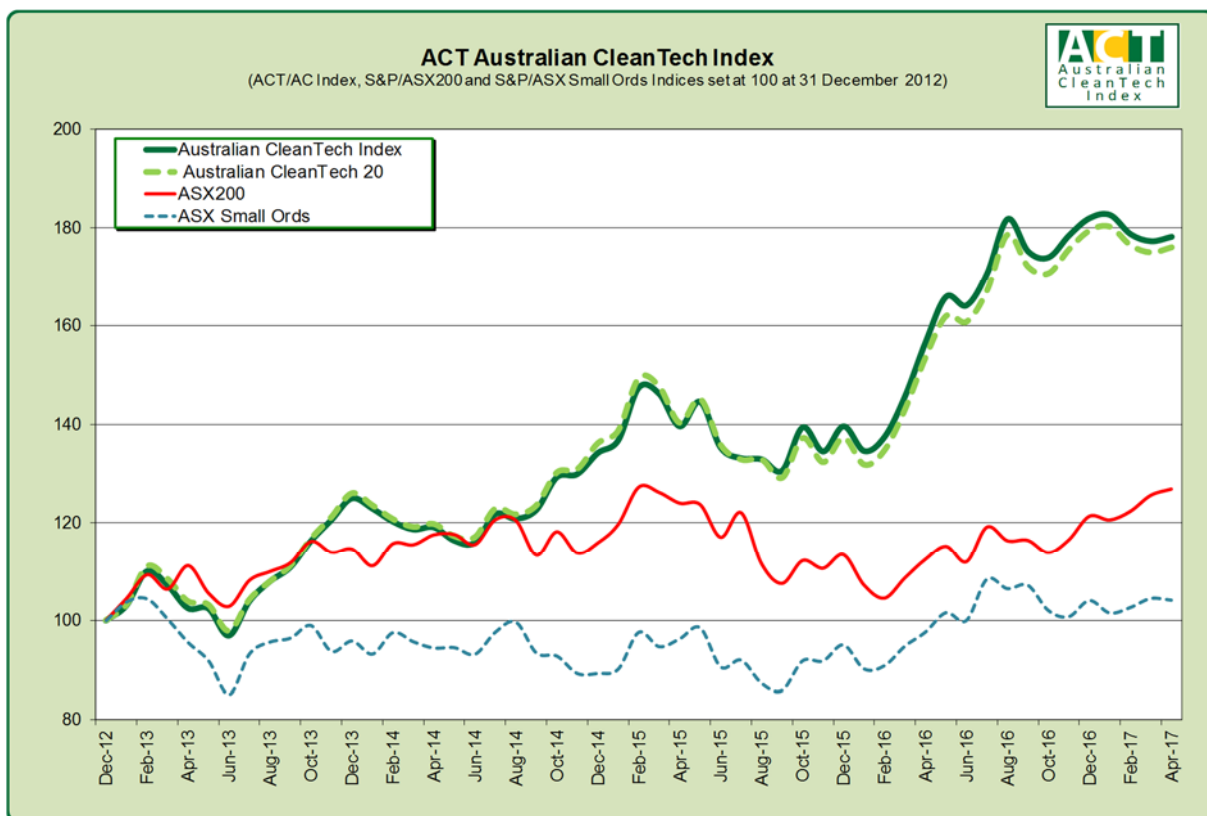
The market capitalisation of the 62 stocks in the Australian CleanTech Index is A\$31.3 billion, down from January's high of \$32.2 billion.

The month's performance included 10 companies with **gains of more than 10%**. The greatest percentage gains were recorded by **Actinogen (ACW)**, **AnaeCo (ANQ)** and **Traffic Technologies (TTI)**. The greatest market capitalisation gain was recorded by **Contact Energy (CEN)**.

These gains were partially offset by another 10 companies recording **losses of more than 10%** led by Range International (RAN), Environmental Group (EGL) and BuildingIQ (BIQ). The greatest market capitalisation loss was recorded by **CleanTeQ (CLQ)**.
