February 2011 Result – Continuing to Trail the Market

The ACT Australian CleanTech Index fell in February 2011 and underperformed both its benchmarks, the S&P ASX200 Index and the S&P Small Ordinaries Index.

The ACT Australian CleanTech Index fell from 57.5 to 56.2 over the month of February recording a 2.3% loss. This compared to the S&P ASX200 gain of 1.3% and the S&P ASX Small Ordinaries Index gain of 0.7%.

Whilst the six month returns for the ACT Australian CleanTech Index remain better than the S&P ASX200, the other longer term measures of the performance all remain significantly below its benchmarks.

The market capitalisation of the 80 stocks in the ACT Australian CleanTech Index is A\$10.9 billion falling from its peak of \$16.3 billion in July 2007.

The month's performance was driven by poor results from Infigen Energy, Australian Renewable Fuels, Phoslock Water Solutions, Transpacific Industries, Galaxy Resources, Orocobre, Coffey Environments and Australian Ethical Investment.

The poor results were partially offset by strong results from Mission NewEnergy, Nanosonics, CBD Energy, Carbon Conscious and Sub Soil Technologies.
