## July 2010 Result – A Cleantech Bounce!

The ACT Australian CleanTech Index increased in July 2010 to a greater extent than its benchmarks, the S&P ASX200 Index and the S&P Small Ordinaries Index.

The ACT Australian CleanTech Index rose from 50.1 to 53.8 over the month of July recording a 7.5% gain. This compared to the S&P ASX200 gain of 4.1% and the S&P ASX Small Ordinaries Index gain of 4.8%.

The longer term measures of the performance of the ACT Australian CleanTech Index all remain significantly below its benchmarks.

The market capitalisation of the 78 stocks in the ACT Australian CleanTech Index is A\$9.9 billion falling from its peak of \$16.3 billion in July 2007.

The month's performance was driven by strong results from many companies including Infigen Energy, Viridis Clean Energy, the Crane Group, Transpacific Industries, Sims Metal Management, Stericorp, Galaxy Resources, Orocobre, Ceramic Fuel Cells, Geodynamics, Geothermal Resources and Coffey Environments. Unusually, there were very few poor performers this month, with CleanTeq being the only company to fall to any great extent.
