

**May 2018 Result:
Water Sector leads the way in May.**

Australian CleanTech Index strongly outperformed the wider market.

The Australian CleanTech Index rose from 64.51 to 67.65 over the month of May recording a **4.86% gain**. This compared to the ASX200 gain of 0.49% and the ASX Small Ordinaries Index gain of 3.68%. The **Australian CleanTech 20** rose by 5.36% for the month.

The CleanTech Index continues to outperform the wider market over longer reported periods with the **three-year performance leading the ASX200 by over 40%**.

The best performing sub-index was the **Australian Water Index** that recorded a 14.3% gain for the month led by strong gains from both **Reece** and **Reliance Worldwide Corp**. The worst performing sub-index for the month was the **Australian Waste Index** with a 1.4% gain.

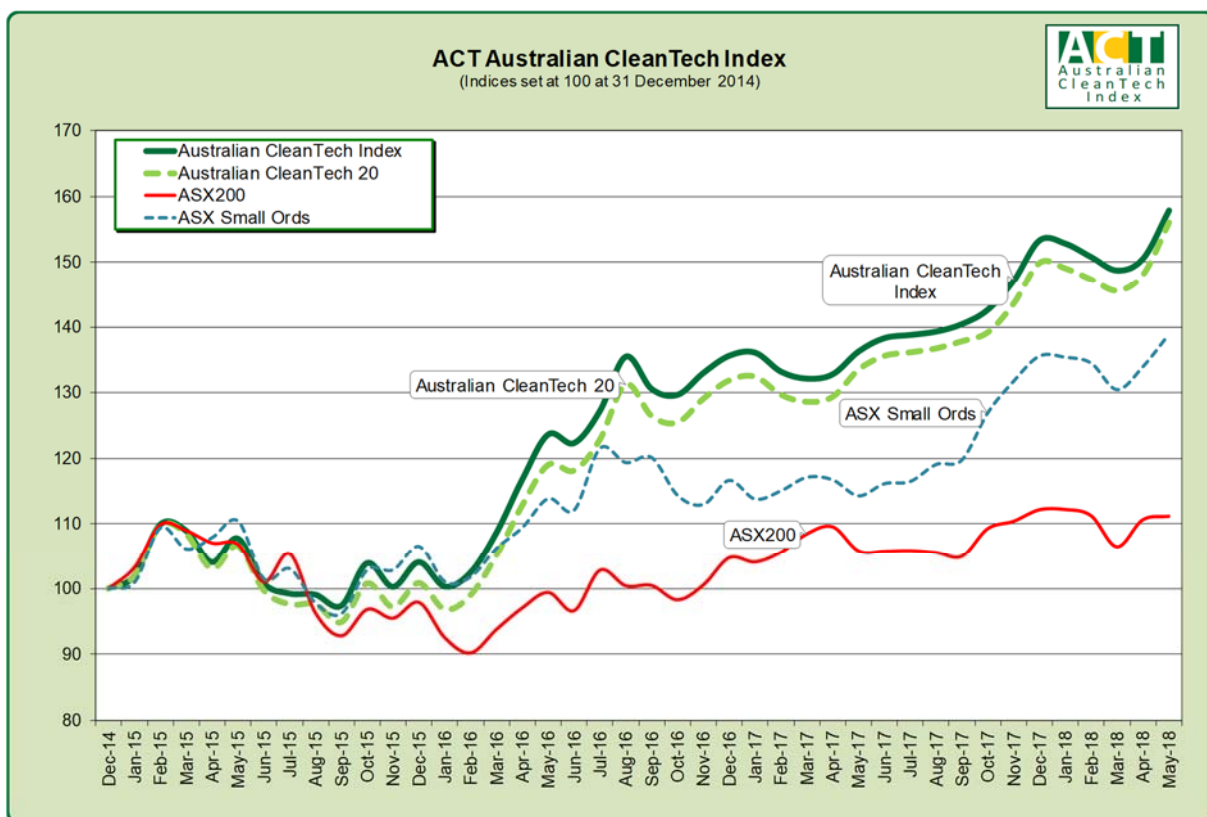
The market capitalisation of the 86 stocks in the Australian CleanTech Index is A\$43.6 billion.

The month's performance included 8 companies with **gains of more than 15%**. The greatest percentage gains were recorded by **Seafarms Group (SFG.AX)**, **EnviroSuite (EVS.AX)** and **HRL Holdings (HRL.AX)**. The greatest market capitalisation gain was recorded by **Reece (REH.AX)**.

These gains were partially offset by 8 companies recording **losses of more than 15%** led by **Papyrus Australia (PPY.AX)**, **RedFlow (RFX.AX)** and **De.Mem (DEM.AX)**. The greatest market capitalisation loss was recorded by **Sims Metal Management (SGM.AX)**.
