



Wine and water put to the test

EASY and accurate on-site testing of water and wine using a biological sensor will move to commercialisation thanks to an Adelaide company winning crucial funding.

The company, CleanFutures AquaSens, has been granted \$50,000 through Bio Innovation SA's Business Development Initiative to finalise prototypes and to complete testing of the technology developed by Victoria's Monash University.

The technology detects nitrates and phosphates in water and sulfites in wine.
